- We measure the realization of environmental goals.
- We take preventive action to prevent harmful environmental effects by taking them into consideration when we make investments.

- We are developing a management system for environmental issues with internal and external evaluation.

Forssa Print's environmental management system fulfills the SFS-ISO 14 001 standard requirements and has been certified by Det Norske Veritas.

Forssa Print's system for monitoring the origin on forest based wood raw material fulfills the requirements of the international standard PEFC-CoC administrated and developed by PEFC Finland - Finnish Forest Certification Council. The monitoring system is certified by DNV Certification Oy/Ab.
